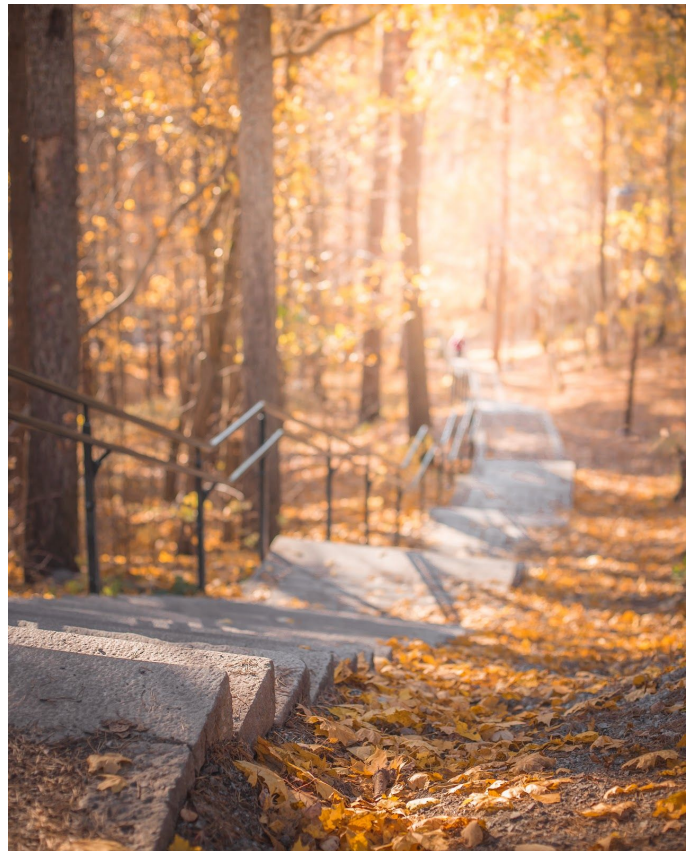
Programme
